BMI – Body Mass Index

What is it and Why is it important

(a measure of body fat based on height and weight that applies to adult men and women.)

For Optimal Health, your BMI should be between 19 and 24

BMI Categories:

Underweight = <18.5 *Normal weight = 18.5–24.9* Overweight = 25–29.9 Obesity = BMI of 30 or greater

If your BMI is **30 or above** (versus under 25).

∞ Your *risk for diabetes* is increased <u>110%</u>

∞ Your *risk for heart disease* is increased <u>98%</u>

∞ Your *risk for any cancer* is increased 25 to 30%

∞ Your *risk Breast Cancer* is increased <u>39%</u> after menopause

∞ Your *risk for recurrent Breast Cancer* is increased <u>46%</u>
